Student Research Grant Program

Competitive grants may be awarded for up to \$1,500 for Ph.D. & Masters Student Research Grants and up to \$1,000 for Undergraduate Student Research

The Kansas Academy of Science (KAS) Student Grant Program has been established to foster the scientific research endeavors of student members of the KAS or students whose major advisor is a member of the KAS. Research funds may be used to support investigation in any scientific field and in any locality.

Funding is to be used by the students to pay for expenses incurred in doing research. Common expenditures are:

- The purchase of supplies & equipment.
- Travel to and from research sites,
- The purchase or collection of data.

Funding may NOT be used for:

- Tuition, room & board, textbooks, curriculum development.
- Salaries or stipends for applicants or assistants,
- Manuscript preparation & publication costs.
